New York's Brill Building Phenomenon

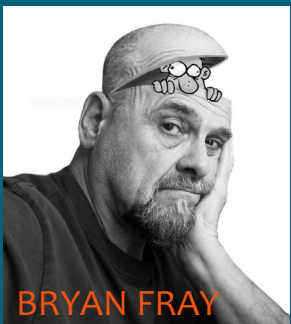
